What is a 10 watt solar panel?

How many watts do you need for a solar panel?

Panel Watts needed = $10 \times 32 / 2 = 160$ Watts!!! 10 Watt load in Summer with 6 sunshine hours/day. Panel watts needed = $10 \times 32 / 6 = 53$ Watts. In practice higher Watts will be needed. In a 5.50 peak sun hour area, a 300-watt solar panel will produce 1.24 kWh per day, 37.13 kWh per month, and 451.69 kWh per year. Example: What Is The Output Of a 100-Watt Solar Panel?
