What is the electricity price in Uzbekistan?

The residential electricity price in Uzbekistan is UZS 295.000 per kWh or USD 0.023. The electricity price for businesses is UZS 900.000 kWh or USD 0.071. These retail prices were collected in March 2024 and include the cost of power, distribution and transmission, and all taxes and fees. Compare Uzbekistan with 150 other countries.

Will Uzbekistan's electricity and gas tariffs increase in 2025?

Moreover, energy companies endure multibillion-dollar losses due to low rates. From May 1, electricity and gas tariffs in Uzbekistan will increase for the first time since August 2019. The subsequent increase is set for April 2025. The government is also introducing "social norms" for gas and electricity use.

How is electricity generated in Uzbekistan?

In Uzbekistan, electricity is generated mainly by harnessing the heat from burning fuels in the form of steam (thermal power). This accounts for about 90% of total generation. The remaining 10% comes from renewable sources like hydropower and wind.

When will gas prices increase in Uzbekistan?

The government is also introducing "social norms" for gas and electricity use. Prices for gas and electricity for population will increase in Uzbekistan starting from May 1, according to a government resolution from April 16. Deputy energy minister Umid Mamadaminov explained the long-postponed changes during a briefing on Tuesday.

How many hydroelectric stations are there in Uzbekistan?

Uzbekistan has 18 large hydroelectric stations. High start-up costs, low gas and electricity prices, and the lack of renewable energy promoting policies are reasons for the limited use of renewable energy sources. Nonetheless, a law "On Renewable Energy Sources" has been drafted.

What is the energy balance of Uzbekistan?

Oil and natural gas comprise 97% of the country's energy balance. Primary energy shares consist of 86.3% gas, 1.9% hydro, 2.5% coal and peat, and 9.3% crude oil. Uzbekistan is the largest electricity producer in Central Asia.
