An Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) is a backup power system that ensures devices and equipment continue functioning during power interruptions. When the main power source (usually the electric grid) experiences a failure, the UPS immediately switches to its backup power, allowing systems to continue operating without disruption.

However batteries cannot provide backup for a very long period of time and have limited charge/discharge cycles.

High-power UPS systems use thyristors with forced commutation circuits as the power switches. Systems with ratings less than 200 kVA now use power transistors or insulated-gate bipolar transistors as the power switches.
